Name one goal you think you could complete this summer.

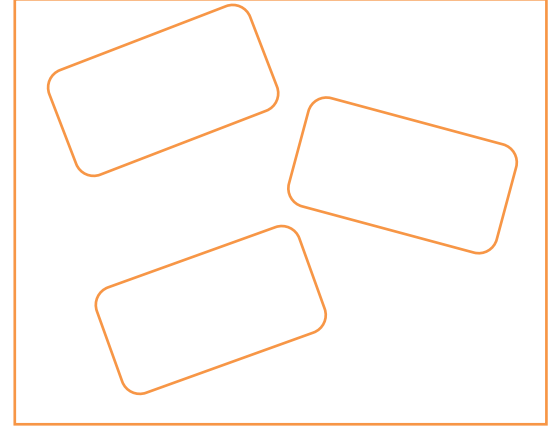
