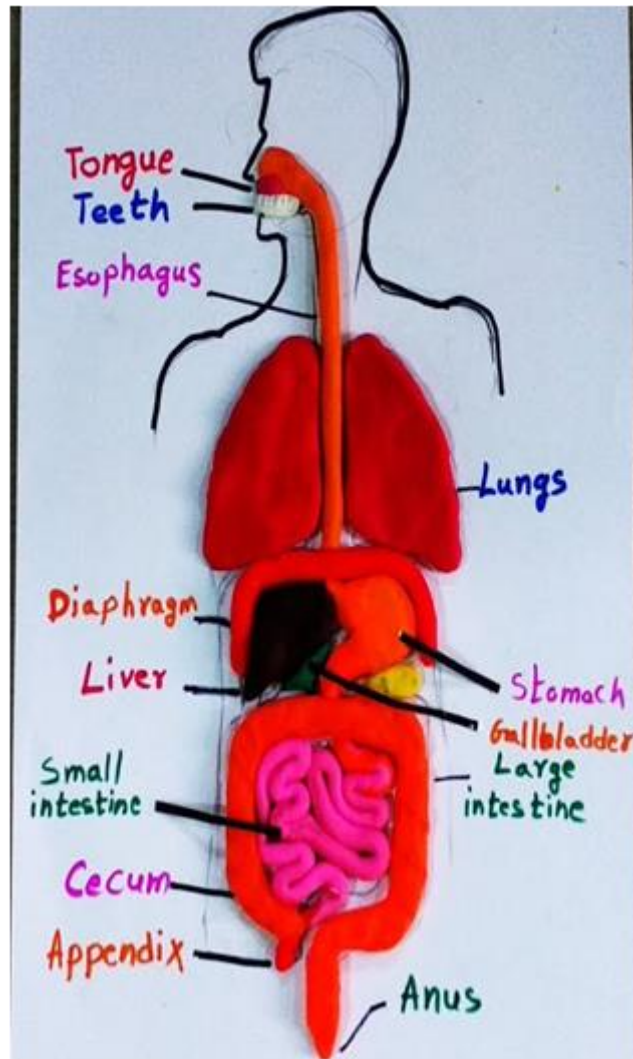
5. On a half chart paper draw Indian and International place value system.
