DO ANY TWO TASKS OUT OF THE THREE GIVEN.

1. Design a Book Jacket

- Create your own book cover (front and back) for a story you love or wrote.
- Add: Title, author, back cover summary, and 3 reviews by imaginary readers!
- Use drawings, colours, and paper design.

2. If I Had a Time Machine...

- Imagine you travel 100 years into the future or past.
- Write a diary entry about what you saw, whom you met, and what surprised you.
- Add a creative sketch from that time.

3. The Magic Doorway

- Draw a Door
- Draw a large, magical door on a piece of paper (it can be of any type you imagine).
- Describe What's Behind the Door
- Write a short story or paragraph about what happens when you open the door.
- Example: "One day, I opened a door and found..."
 - Add Details to the Drawing
 - Draw the scene or characters that you describe in your story around the door.
 - Colour the Picture and Story
 - Use colours to make your door and surroundings look exciting and magical.
